VESSEL STOPPED AND THREE MALES CHARGED

(TEMAGAMI, ON) - On September 11, 2017 at approximately 12:23 a.m., members of the Temiskaming Detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) were dispatched to assist Bear Island First Nation police with a theft of copper.

Police received information about the theft from the partnership of the Temagami Lake Watch and as result; three males were arrested and charged at 1:06 a.m. on the above-mentioned date.

James Joseph PAUL, (34) years of age of Bear Island was arrested and charged with the following:

- Operate vessel while ability impaired by alcohol, contrary to section 253(1) of the Criminal Code (CC)
- Theft Under \$5000, contrary to section 334(b) of the CC
- Break and enter a place – commit indicatable offence, contrary to section 348(1)(b) of the CC
- Possession of property obtained by crime under \$5000 (x2) - in Canada, contrary to section 354(1) of the CC

The accused was held for bail and is scheduled to appear at the Ontario Court of Justice, in Haileybury, Ontario, on September 15, 2017.

Jonathan James PAUL, (39) years of age of Bear Island was arrested and charged with the following:

- Theft Under \$5000, contrary to section 334(b) of the CC
- Break and enter a place – commit indicatable offence, contrary to section 348(1)(b) of the CC
- Possession of property obtained by crime under \$5000 (x2) - in Canada, contrary to section 354(1) of the CC

The accused was held for bail and is scheduled to appear at the Ontario Court of Justice, in Haileybury, Ontario, on September 15, 2017.

Nathaniel Christopher PAUL (28) of Bear Island was arrested and charged with the following:

- Theft Under \$5000, contrary to section 334(b) of the CC
