With the number of cases of COVID increasing at a rapid rate, more than ever it's extremely important to keep your contact with others to a minimum. Be very aware of who you are with and know how to reach everyone. If you are to test positive you will be expected to notify all of your contacts. The rule of thumb is to go back 48 hours prior to the onset of symptoms.

With cases locally in Temagami and all around us on the rise, everyone needs to **REMAIN VIGILANT** with public health measures, including physical distancing, hand sanitizing and masking. Please, even if you are fully vaccinated, ensure that you continue to follow these guidelines.

YOU ARE ENCOURAGED TO KEEP NEW YEAR CELEBRATIONS SMALL AND WITHIN YOUR HOUSEHOLD.

The Ontario government, in consultation with the Chief Medical Officer of Health, has applied additional public health and workplace safety measures, including **capacity and social gathering limits**. Our local Health Unit strongly recommends that:

- Everyone should limit social gatherings at private dwellings to no more than 10 people indoors and 25 people outdoor. All attendees 12 years of age and older should be vaccinated.
- All unvaccinated individuals 12 years of age and older should avoid any non-essential indoor contact with individuals who are not part of their household.
- Where possible, individuals should work remotely.
